

The population of the study consists of high school students from Bhakkar, with a total population of 4,000 students. A sample size of 300 students was selected using a simple

Research Consultancy on Social & Management Development & Thal University Bhakkar	questionnaire. The data analysis was carried out using SPSS and Smart PLS SEM. The findings of the study reveal a significant relationship between school safety and bullying behavior, with improved safety correlating with a reduction in bullying. Furthermore, peer relationships also have a significant effect on bullying behavior. Most importantly, the study identifies a significant mediating role of self-control between school safety, peer relationships, and bullying behavior. This research holds important implications for schools, educators, and policymakers.
